

SOCIAL SCIENCE (SSCI)

SSCI 2101. Introduction to Social Science. (3 Credits)

An interdisciplinary survey of several fields comprising social and behavioral sciences. Offered: As Needed.

SSCI 2151H. Honors Directed Independent Study. (3 Credits)

This course covers special topics of interest to students under the direction of a faculty specialist in the field. Approval of faculty member, department chair, and Honors Program Co-Director required. A student may enroll for no more than nine (9) hours of course work through Honors Directed Independent Study. Prerequisite: Completion of nine (9) credit hours of Honors Program courses. This course is a free elective (not in the core). Offered: As Needed.

SSCI 2400. Microcomputers in Social Sci. (3 Credits)**SSCI 2402. Microcomputers in Social Science. (3 Credits)**

Introduces social science majors to the practical utilization of microcomputers and selected computer application packages in the social sciences. Offered: Fall, Spring, Summer.
